The following projects are emblematic of the work that we do with small businesses. With any given project, we are able to assist in a variety of ways depending on the needs of the small business owner.



**Detroit Shipping Company.** Parkstone Development Partners provided interpretation and facilitation of the Michigan Building Code and Zoning Ordinance regarding shipping container use as needed for project financing, as well as assistance with land use entitlements including a lot combination, re-zoning, parking calculations, and a special land use hearing as part of the zoning and site plan review process. Additionally, Parkstone consulted on health department issues during the permitting process.

**Founders Brewery.** Parkstone assisted with initial site assessment including developing a land use strategy to redevelop a non-conforming commercial building in a residential zoning district. This required approval of the use and a parking variance from the Board of Zoning Appeals as well as site plan approval from Planning & Development.
